Livestreaming with SWITCHcast or with ZOOM/Teams

1. Livestreaming with SWITCHcast

From the start of the Fall semester 2021, livestreaming will also be possible with SWITCHcast. Compared to livestreaming with Zoom, preparation and handling in the lecture hall are much easier. All media devices (SMARTPodium, visualizer, lecture hall computer, personal notebook) can be used in the lecture hall and the teaching staff will not have to adjust any hardware or software settings in the lecture hall.

By default, this setup streams the speaker via the installed room camera with a fixed image section, the screen presentation as well as the sound (especially of the wireless microphones), but not the blackboard or the overhead projector.

Communication between speaker and participants requires a chat tool. Starting in the Fall semester 2022, an integrated chat tool will be available as well.

The livestream is always recorded and may optionally be made available as a podcast after streaming concludes.

For licensing reasons, this service is initially limited to lectures with more than 300 participants.

2. Livestreaming with ZOOM/Teams

Listed below are the rooms that are equipped for livestreaming with ZOOM/Teams (i.e., technically speaking video conferencing). Please note that any existing room cameras will not be integrated, i.e. only the screen presentation as well as the sound (especially of the wireless microphones) and the computer-internal camera will be transmitted. The Visualizer can be connected to the computer via USB and thus integrated into ZOOM or Teams. ZOOM and Teams are installed on the lecture hall computers and SmartBoard computers. However, we recommend using a personal notebook.

Questions by external students cannot be asked via audio channel and are limited to chat only. Faculties are still encouraged to provide their own first level support to help teaching staff set up and test the ZOOM conference in the lecture room.



For individual special events, support for live streaming with Zoom can be requested even in rooms that are not already equipped for this purpose. However, this offer is dependent on the availability of AV staff, who must set up the required infrastructure separately for each stream. Please direct inquiries to zoom-support@zi.uzh.ch.
